
Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for the Troy Regional Medical Center Hospital Infrastructure Upgrades in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Troy Regional Medical Center, located at 1330 US Hwy 231, Troy, Alabama 36081. The funding would be used for modernizing and replacing aging boilers, emergency generators, and elevators at Troy Regional Medical Center to ensure safe, reliable, and efficient hospital operations.
